Letter to Interface Graphics, Inc. Customers Regarding CSPIA Compliance

Dear Interface Graphics Customer,

On August 14, 2008, the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) was signed into law. The CPSIA changes the requirements associated with consumer products intended primarily for use by children ages 12 and younger. Children's products, including books made from paper, are subject to the CPSIA's new total lead and phthalates content limits beginning on February 10, 2009.

Commencing February 10, 2009, Interface Graphics will be posting a General Certification of Conformity on its website www.igigraphics.com. Interface Graphics has an exemplary safety record and devotes considerable resources to manage our supply chain to produce safe and compliant products. A review of certifications and testing reports from our suppliers confirms that the materials used to produce our books do not contain lead and phthalate in amounts that exceed the limits set by the CPSIA.
